# car hire

It is not a problem to drive in Croatia. The roads are generally in good condition and the drivers reasonably well behaved. Driving is on the right hand side of the road.

As outlined in the Getting Around section, a car is not essential in Stari Grad, and you could hire one in Stari Grad for the odd day that you want to make a special trip.

Your first choice may be Hvar Touristik Agency as an official Europcar representative on the Island.
